About a week ago I found Mercy Times Radio. I live in Northern New Hampshire, and there are no Catholic radio stations. I can't listen to your show live, so I tune in by podcast. Needless to say, I've downloaded just about all that is available on the server to date. I seem to be wearing out my hard drive playing your series on the Spiritual Works of Mercy.
